



Spring Mountain Ranch 2013 – 8th Annual



Nevada Day - October 25th, 26th, and 27th, 2013

Re-enactor Information:

1. **Units, Camps, or Individuals wishing to attend must be Invited by the Event Organizer (Jason Coffey), or be regular units of the ACWS, Inc., the SNLHA, the UTCWA, the SWCWA, the NMCWCC, or members of PACWR.** All members of these groups must have current membership cards, or have pre-registered 30 days out (End of September).
2. Groups not previously mentioned above, that have a **standing arrangement with the ACWS, Inc.**, will have that attendance understanding honored as normal.
3. Any other “standing” Unit or Camp wishing to attend the Southwest Invitation is encouraged to do so. However, you must contact the Event Coordinator (Jason Coffey) no later than 45 days out (September 11th) from the event to be guaranteed inclusion in the Event Documentation with State Parks.
4. To be clear, there is **NO COST TO PRE-REGISTARED REENACTORS** who have Pre-Registered individually or as a Unit/Camp 30 days (End of September) prior to the event. We are very fortunate to be able to continue offering this since the event was started.
5. Participants who have NOT pre-registered, may be required to pay the State Park gate fee to get into the park. That fee is NON-Refundable by either State Parks or the ACWS/SNLHA. You will be given a parking pass onsite afterwards if any are available.
6. Participants who have NOT pre-registered, and lack a current membership card from their organization, or a PACWR Letter, will have to purchase a \$10 Event Pass from the ACWS, Inc. Membership Booth prior to setting up onsite.
7. Participants who cause trouble, refuse to follow the PACWR minimum safety standard, or fail to heed the above, will be removed or fined at the discretion of Nevada State Parks and Event Staff.
8. Participants who do not pay for their Event T-Shirts in advance of the Event, will NOT have one made or reserved for you. Thanks to everyone who helps to support the event by doing so.
9. Camps/Units/Individuals that are Pre-Registered may **setup** as early as Friday at Noon, and **take down** as late as Monday at Noon after the event.
10. Battalion and higher Staff for both sides, ACWS Board Members, and approved School Day Participants may setup as early as 2pm on the Thursday before the event. Any others must have advance permission from the Event Coordinator (*Jason Coffey 702-354-6875*) to do so. IE: Drive over 8 hours, etc.
11. We have 24 hour access to the site for Pre-Registered participants.

12. Camps/Units/Individuals that are Pre-Registered will have their names added to our FREE Civilian Raffle on Saturday during the Ladies Tea, and our FREE Military Raffle on Sunday after the second battle.
13. **You must be present to win at the Participant Raffles.**
14. Military Units that have Pre-Registered more than 45 days out (September 11th) will be guaranteed eligibility for bounties.
15. Military Bounties are issued as an incentive based on the number of battles you have participated in, not just for the event overall. For Artillery and Cavalry, these are limited incentives "first come, first served" for people living outside of the area, and will be evenly divided amongst both sides in advance of the event.
16. Units/Camps/Individuals wishing to participate in the **Friday School Day** must Pre-Register 45 days out (September 11th) to guaranteed inclusion in the School Day planning and advertising.
17. Units/Camps/Individuals who are **approved to participate** in the School Day may arrive as early as Thursday at 2pm to setup.
18. **Sutlers (Vendors)** who do not pre-register at least 45 days out (September 11th) from the event, may not be included in the advertising or program.
19. For Sutlers that pre-registar, the "Sutler Fees" will follow the standard ACWS, Inc. Sutler fee schedule.
20. Pre-Registered Sutlers may setup as early as Thursday Noon, and leave as late as Monday Noon.
21. Sutlers that have not Pre-Registered more than 30 days out (End of September), may not be allowed to setup onsite as space has not been allocated to your Sutlery. In the very least you will have to wait till everyone else gets situated first. Please contact the Sutler Coordinator (Janice Palmer) in advance of the event.
22. Anyone selling items during the event is considered to be a Sutler, will be required to setup on Sutler Row, to pay their "Sutler Fee" to the ACWS Treasurer before setup, and to maintain their receipt during the event.
23. **Food Vendors** are directed to talk to the Sutler Coordinator (Janice Palmer) to make arrangements to be at the event at least 45 days out (September 11th).
24. Food Vendors who do not pre-register at least 45 days out (September 11th) from the event, may not be included in the advertising or program.
25. **Community Information Booths** will be handled on a case by case basis. Please contact the Event Coordinator (*Jason Coffey 702-354-6875*) at least 45 days out (September 11th) to guarantee space for your Booth.
